

## ASIAN HOCKEY FEDERATION WITHDRAWAL POLICY

## **Participating Countries**

Other than for reasons accepted by the Council of the Asian Hockey Federation (AHF) as a force majure or exceptional circumstances, when a member National Hockey Association (NHA) confirms participation in a competition controlled by the AHF and following that withdraws with less than 2 months to the said competition, the following sanctions shall apply:

- For the first withdrawal, the NHA shall pay AHF a sum of US\$500.
- For the second such withdrawal within a period of 4 years, the NA shall pay AHF a sum of US\$1,000. The AHF Council shall also have the discretion to suspend the NHA from participating in any competition for whatever period as the AHF Council shall deem appropriate.

## **Host Country**

Other than for reasons accepted by the Council of the Asian Hockey Federation (AHF) as a force majure, when a member National Hockey Association (NHA) confirms the hosting of a competition controlled by the AHF and following that withdraws with less than 6 months to the said competition, the following sanctions shall apply:

- 1 Forfeiture of the hosting fee (if any); or
- 2 If there is no hosting fee, the NHA shall pay the AHF all expenses incurred in securing new host country; and
- The NHA may be suspended from hosting any competitions for such time as the AHF Council shall determine.
